Formerly known as SRL Ranbaxy, Super Religare Laboratories (SRL) is the largest chain of laboratories in the country



Established in 1995 in Mumbai, SRL is the only diagnostic network built around four zonal clinical

reference lab set-ups - one each in Mumbai, Bangalore, Kolkata and Gurgaon. These zonal centres then further support other satellite laboratory system and the collection centres. The company has 40 labs, 850 collection centres across India, out of which 10 labs are located in the Delhi-NCR. SRL has also spread its wings globally as it has 30 collection centres in SAARC, Gulf, Europe, the UK and North America.

The first lab that it set-up in Delhi was at Jessa Ram Hospital in Karol Bagh. Approximately 4,000 different types of tests that are conducted here and the tests range from biochemistry to histopathology and even molecular diagnostics. "SRL is the only diagnostic network to

have a dedicated R&D set-up which constantly strives to introduce newer state-of-the-art technology platforms and that too after tailoring them according to the needs of Indian diaspora," says Dr Sanjeev K Chaudhry, CEO, SRL Ranbaxy.
